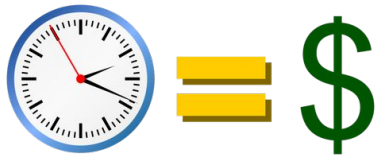

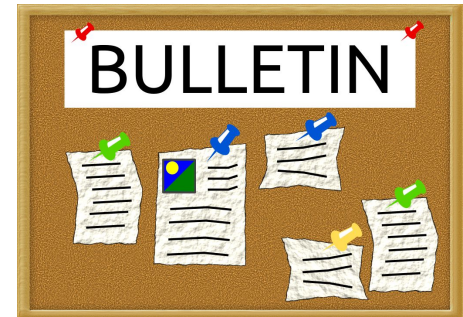
Request for Letters of Recommendation
